

I wish to express my alarm over the Yucca Mountain Project, and the process now pushing it toward approval.

I am at a loss to understand how the Secretary of Energy can be preparing to recommend Yucca Mountain for a high-level nuclear waste dump when thousands of public comments on the Draft Environmental Impact Statement still have not been addressed?

Without a final E.I.S., a detailed transportation scenario, finalized Siting Guidelines, or a licensing rule, the Department of Energy lacks the basis for

consideration of site suitability.

How are we, the public, to have confidence in any recommendation that arises from such a dramatically flawed process? It's impossible. I strongly urge you to abandon the Yucca Mountain Project.
