Yes to proceed YMP

I have been involved with nuclear power generation for more than 40 years in Japan. I am also the emeritus member of the American Nuclear Society.

I hope you will proceed the Yucca Mountain Project as scheduled. We know that DOE has been doing very broad and detailed study on every aspects of site characterization on Yucca Mountain for more than 14 years.

Although land spacing of the US is huge, you have selected only one site as a candidate for the final repository of the high level nuclear wastes.

Unless you proceed to YMP as scheduled, no other country in the world cannot select a suitable repository within its own regional territory.

Japanese land spacing is very limited (one fiftieth compared to the US), and we have now difficulties in selecting a candidate site for study as a final repository.

If we cannot find out a suitable site in the geologic formation in Japan, we might had to rely on disposing the HLNW to the subseabed basin underneath the Pacific Ocean. Such procedure was called "Subseabed Disposal Program", and its original study was performed by Sandia National Labatory some 40 years ago.
