 Dear Madams and Sirs--

Thank you for giving us the opportunity to comment on the storage of nuclear waste at Yucca Mountain. I am sorry to have missed the deadline--I hope that you will still consider my comments.

I am against storage of nuclear waste at Yucca Mountain, not so much because of the site itself, but because of what it represents--no matter how suitable the site is, it is not immune to catastrophe or attack. The fact is that we do not have safe places to store

the nuclear waste that we are creating, and to make storage areas available encourages more development of nuclear energy and weapons.

I oppose using Yucca Mountain as a storage site and hope that the refusal of the public to accept storage in their communities will lead to development of safer and cleaner technologies. Allowing storage in Nevada is tantamount to allowing storage in the middle of San Francisco--if we do not begin efforts to curtail our production of nuclear waste now we will be forced to store waste closer and closer to our communities.
